The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974 (FERPA) is a federal law designed to protect the privacy of student educational records. Students may grant the Equity, Civil Rights, and Title IX Office (ECRT) permission to release information to a third party by submitting this consent form. By signing this form, I understand that this authorization for release of confidential information applies only to the individual or organization named below and does not permit information concerning me to be obtained/released to any other unauthorized third party. However, my revocation will not affect any information that has already been released prior to ECRT receiving my written request.
